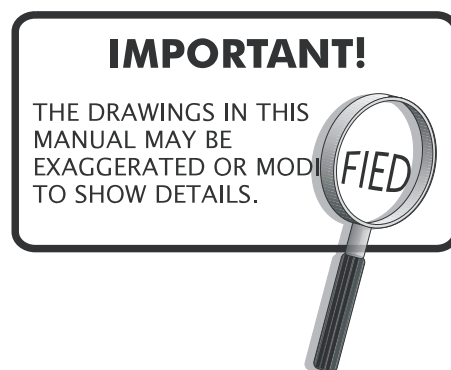

Make sure you understand the following tips before you begin to assemble your hockey table.

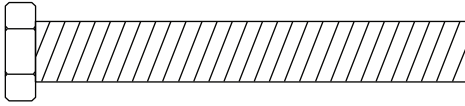
1. Start all bolts by hand before tightening.
2. Some drawings or images in this manual may not look exactly like your product. Please read and understand the text before starting each assembly step.



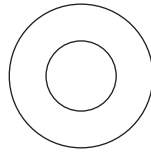

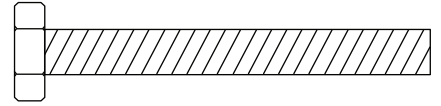

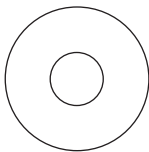

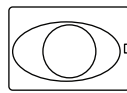

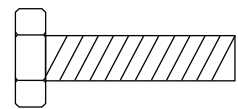

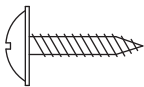

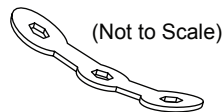

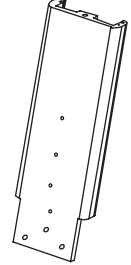

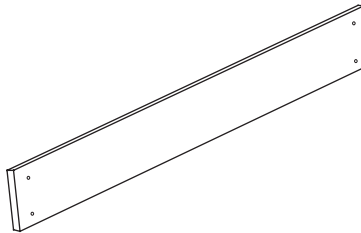

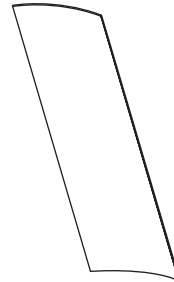

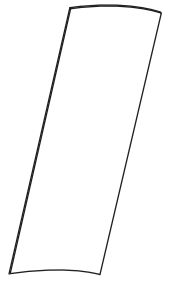

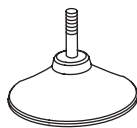

## PARTS REQUIRED:

12 pcs - **H1** Hex Bolt

12 pcs - **H2** Flat Washer

1 pc - **P1** Hockey Table Cabinet

2 pcs - **P2** Right Leg

2 pcs - **P3** Left Leg

1 pc - **T1** Wrench

### STEP 1:

To assemble this table, leave **P1** Hockey Table Cabinet face down in the carton lid.

Attach **P2** Right Legs and **P3** Left Legs using **H1** Hex Bolts with **H2** Flat Washers as shown in **FIGURE 1**.

**Do not tighten H1 Bolts until completion of STEP 4.**

#### IMPORTANT NOTE:

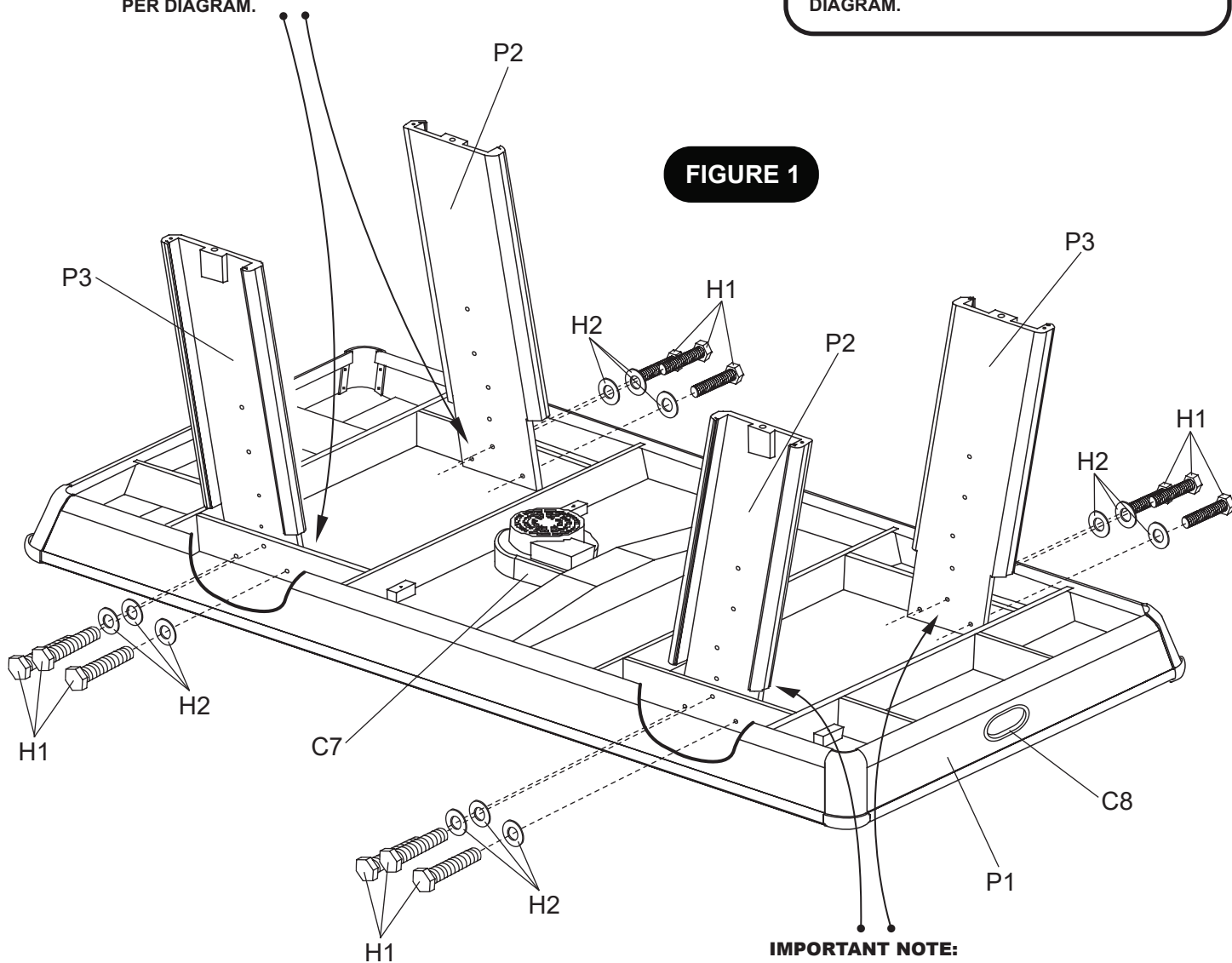
BE SURE **P2-RIGHT LEGS** AND **P3-LEFT LEGS** ARE INSTALLED **INSIDE** OF SUPPORT BEAMS AS PER DIAGRAM.



#### CAUTION:

PLEASE BE SURE TO ASSEMBLE **P2-RIGHT LEGS** AND **P3-LEFT LEGS** EXACTLY AS PER DIAGRAM.

#### IMPORTANT NOTE:

BE SURE **P2-RIGHT LEGS** AND **P3-LEFT LEGS** ARE INSTALLED **INSIDE** OF SUPPORT BEAMS AS PER DIAGRAM.

## PARTS REQUIRED:

8 pcs - **H3** Hex Bolt  
8 pcs - **H4** Flat Washer

8 pcs - **H5** Barrel Nut  
2 pcs - **P4** End Leg Panel

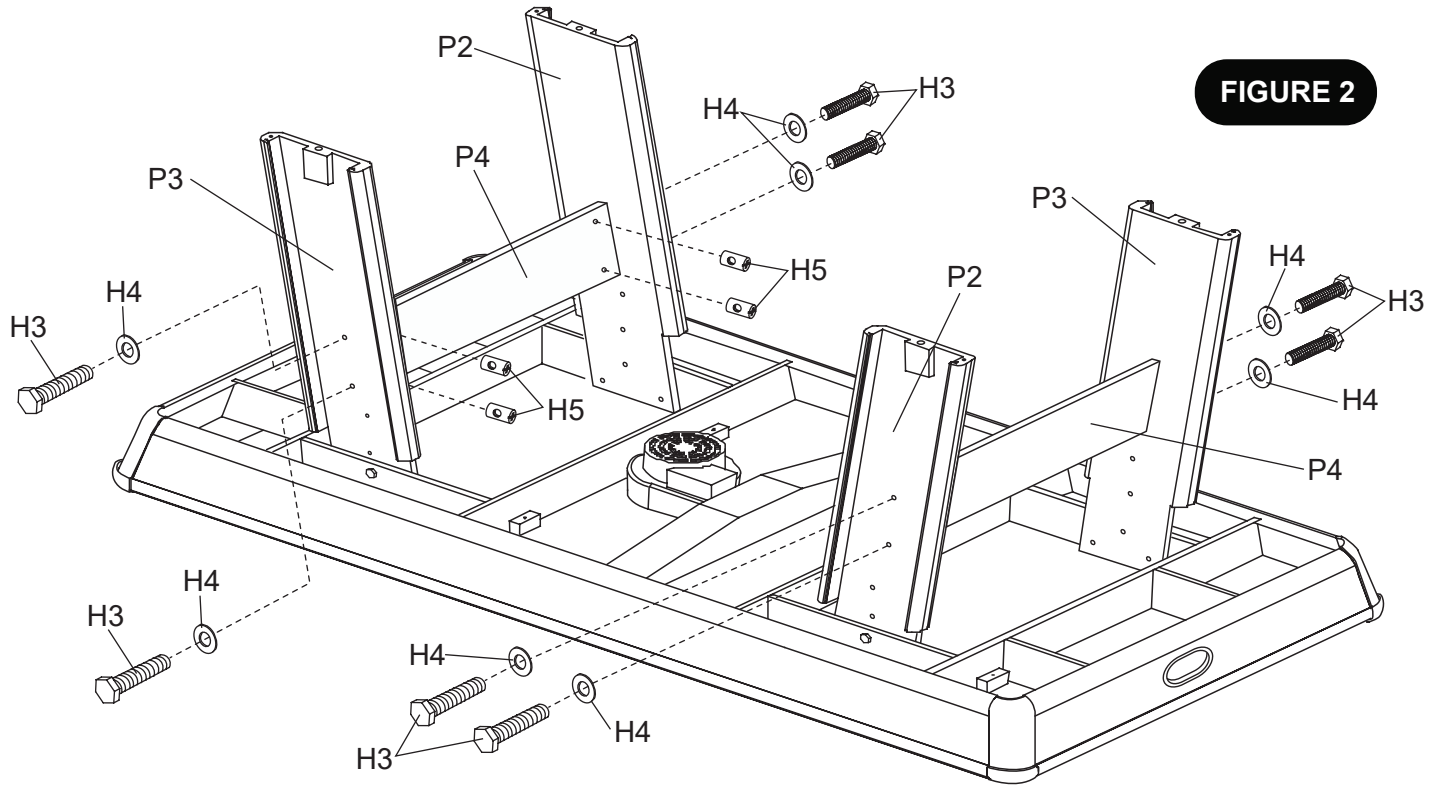
2 pcs - **P6** Right Cover Leg Panel  
2 pcs - **P7** Left Cover Leg Panel

1 pc - **T1** Wrench

### STEP 2:

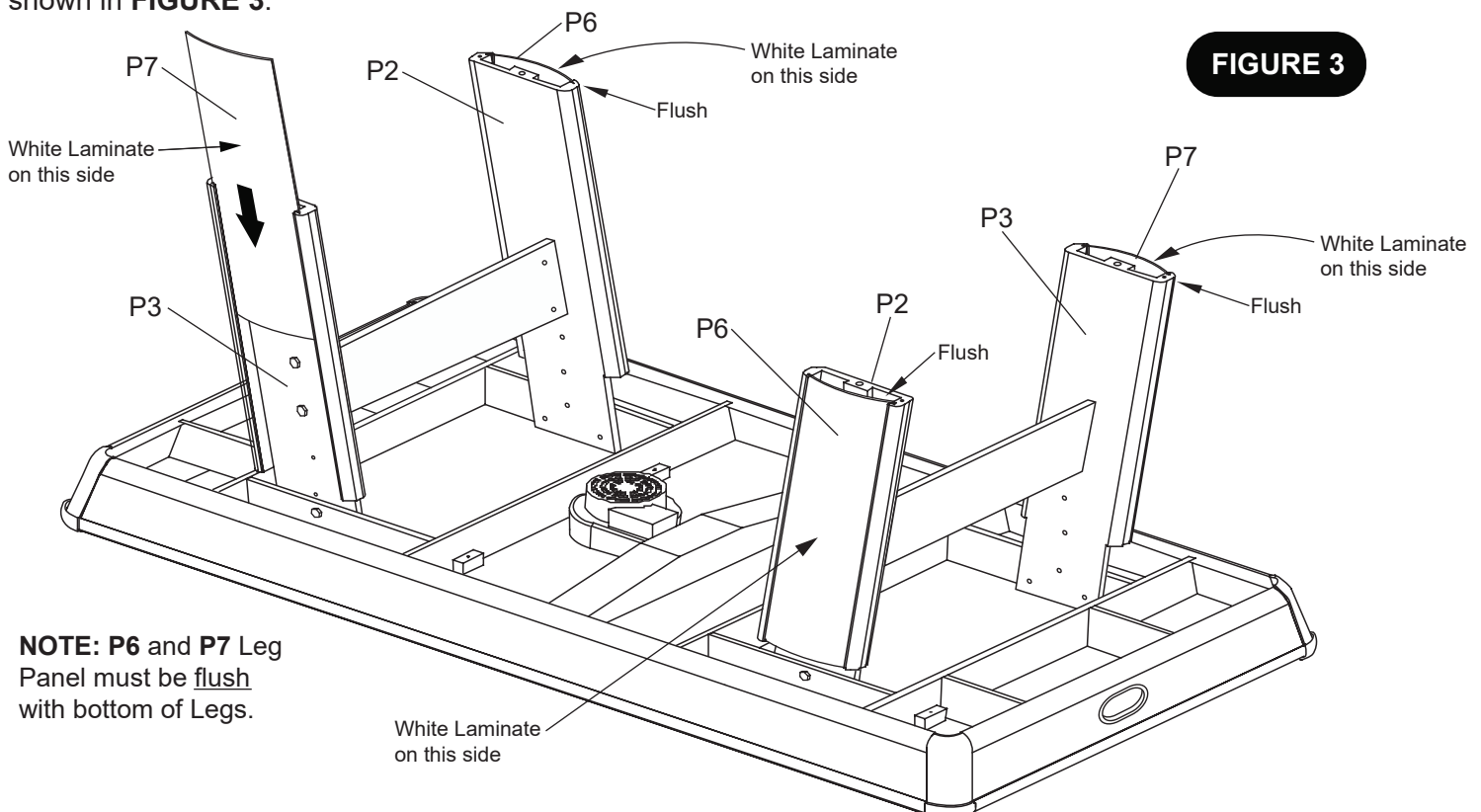
Attach **P4** End Leg Panels between two legs of **P2** Right Legs and **P3** Left Legs using **H3** Hex Bolts with **H4** Flat Washers and **H5** Barrel Nuts as shown in **FIGURE 2**. Use **T1** Wrench to tighten all bolts.

**Important Note:** Tighten, but do not over tighten **H3** Bolts.



### STEP 3:

Carefully bow and slide **P6** Right Leg Panel and **P7** Left Leg Panel into the grooves of each leg assembly as shown in **FIGURE 3**.



**NOTE:** **P6** and **P7** Leg Panel must be flush with bottom of Legs.

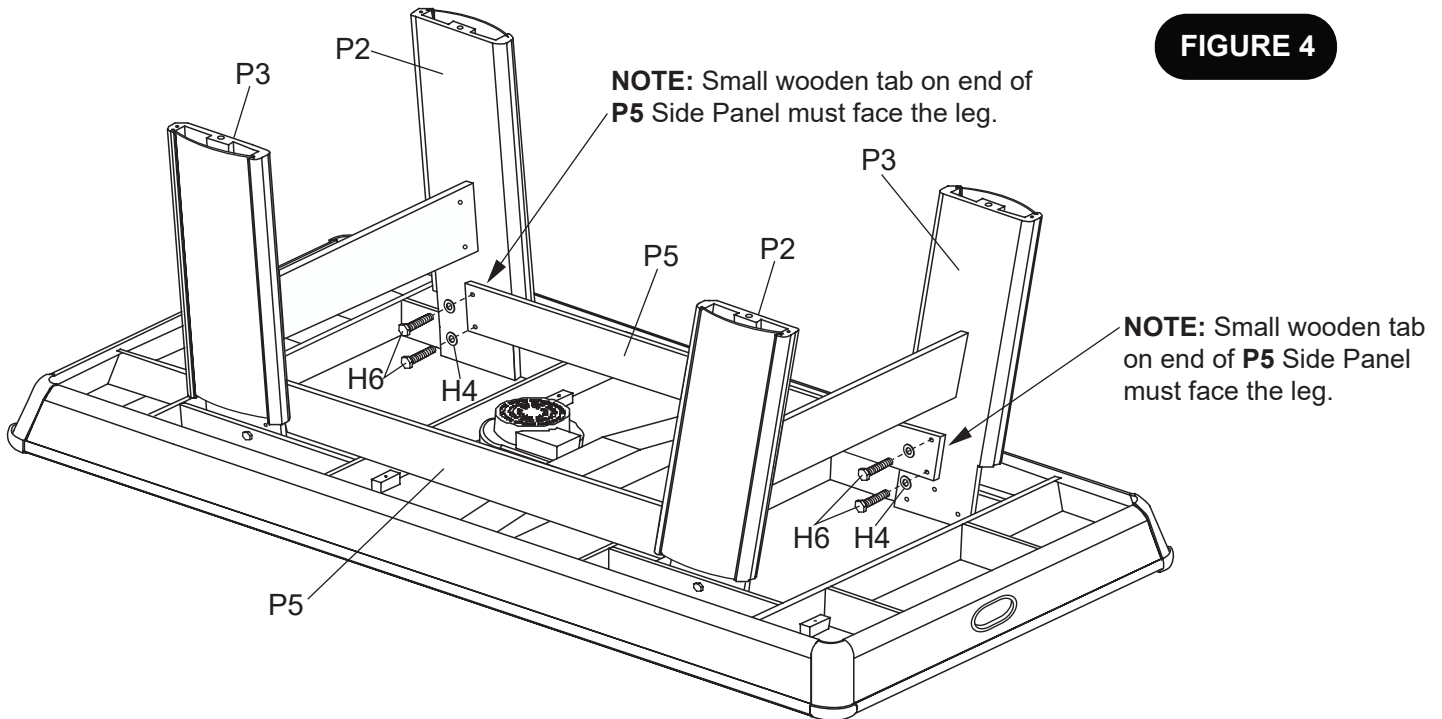

## PARTS REQUIRED:

8 pcs - **H6** Hex Bolt      4 pcs - **H7** Screw      4 pcs - **P8** Leg Panel Support Block      1 pc - **T1** Wrench  
 8 pcs - **H4** Flat Washer      2 pcs - **P5** Side Leg Panel      4 pcs - **P9** Leg Leveler

### STEP 4:

Attach **P5** Side Leg Panels between **P2** Right Legs and **P3** Left Legs using **H6** Hex Bolts with **H4** Flat Washers as shown in **FIGURE 4**. Use **T1** Wrench to tighten all bolts. **Remember to tighten all H1 Leg Bolts from STEP 1.**

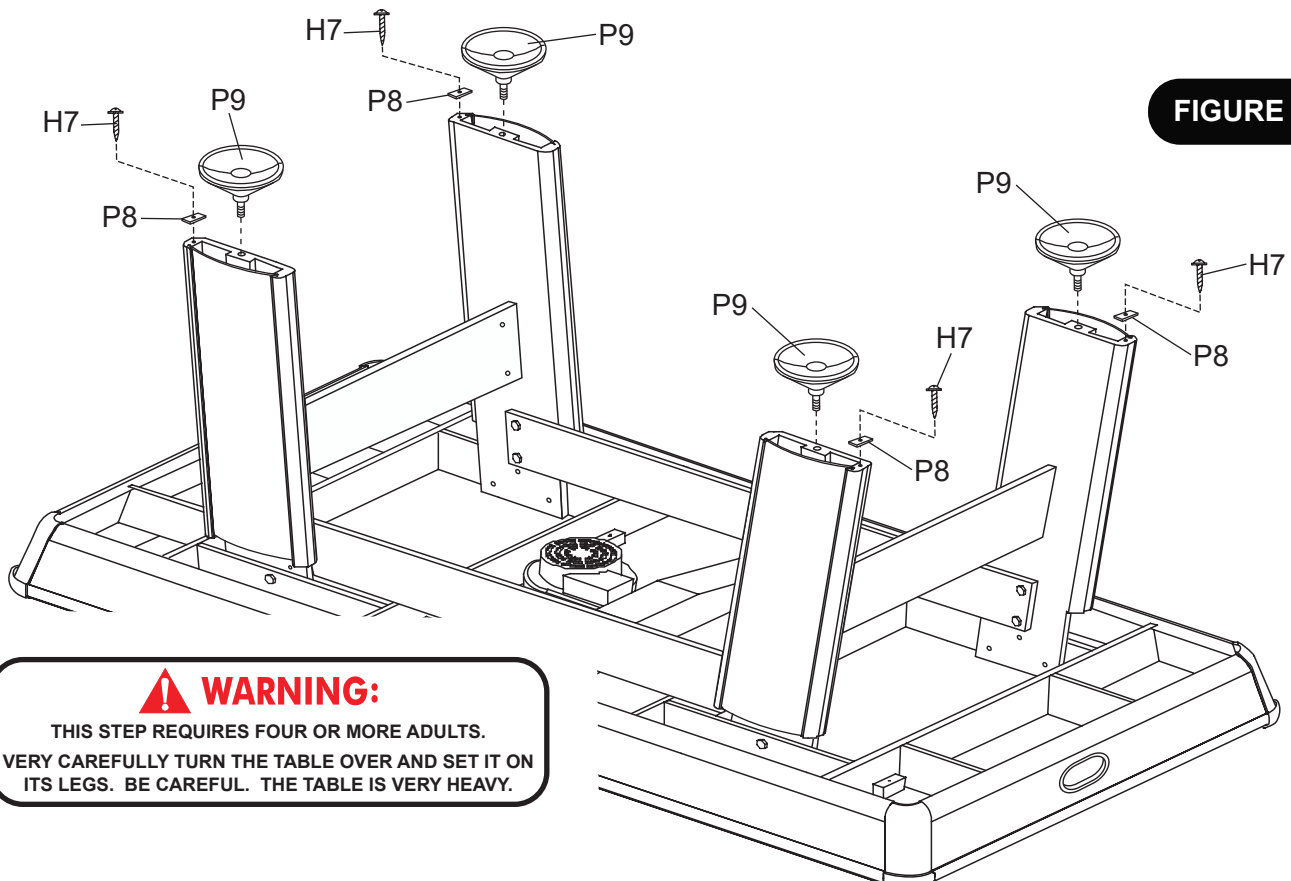

### STEP 5:

Attach **P8** Leg Panel Support Blocks to bottom of Leg assembly using pre-drilled pilot hole with **H7** Screws as shown in **FIGURE 5**. **Tighten, but do not strip out H7 screws.**

Thread **P9** Leg Levelers into the Leg assembly as shown in **FIGURE 5**.

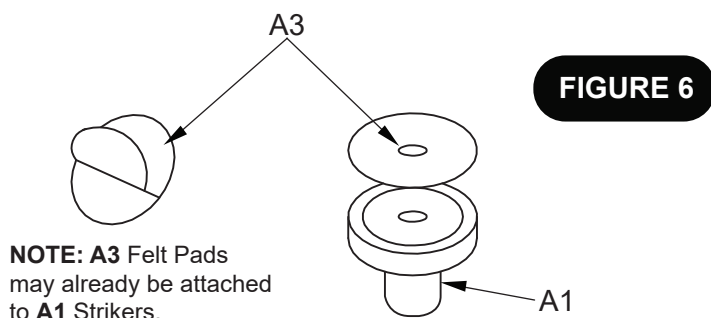


### **WARNING:**

## STEP 6:

Peel the backing off **A3** Felt Pad and attach to **A1** Striker as shown in **FIGURE 6**.



**Congratulations! You have now assembled your HJ SCOTT Hockey Table. Please note the instructions below to ensure many years of trouble free use of your HJ SCOTT Hockey Table.**

### CARE AND USE OF YOUR HJ SCOTT HOCKEY TABLE

1. Use only a suitable 120v AC household outlet, and insure the cord is not a trip hazard.
2. Spray furniture polish is recommended to both protect the play field and increase the puck speed. Apply and wipe off with the air motor on.
3. Use a carpenters level to properly level table using the leg levelers.
4. This product is intended for **INDOOR** use only.
5. **DO NOT** operate the motor if the cord is damaged in any way.
6. **DO NOT** sit, climb or lean on the table.
7. **DO NOT** drag the table when moving it. This will damage the legs.
8. **DO NOT** set drinks on the table.
9. It is suggested that this table be placed close to a wall thus allowing the air motor cord to **NOT** be a trip hazard. Always turn air motor off when table is **NOT** in use.

#### Suggestion:


- The purchase of a 8 ft Pool Table cover will both protect and help keep table clean while table is not in use.

### ELECTRONIC SCORER OPERATION:

1. Plug the power cord from the ON/OFF switch into a wall outlet.
2. Press the red ON/OFF switch on end apron to turn the air motor on.
3. This game includes a new touch panel control box with familiar icons to control the electronic scorer. Each icon is described below.

 = Power ON/OFF – Press this button to turn the electronic scorer ON or OFF.

 = Sound ON/OFF – Press this button while the game is on to turn the sound ON or OFF.

 = Start / Reset – Press this button to begin the game. Press this button at end of game to reset back to the same game option.

 = Time – Press this button to select time options 15 minutes, 10 minutes, 5 minutes or “No Time Limit”.

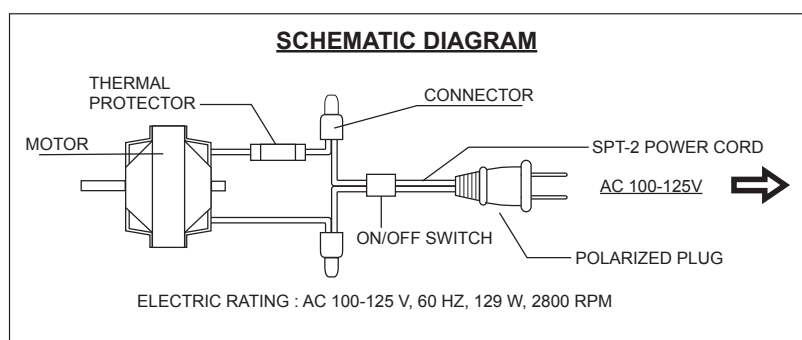
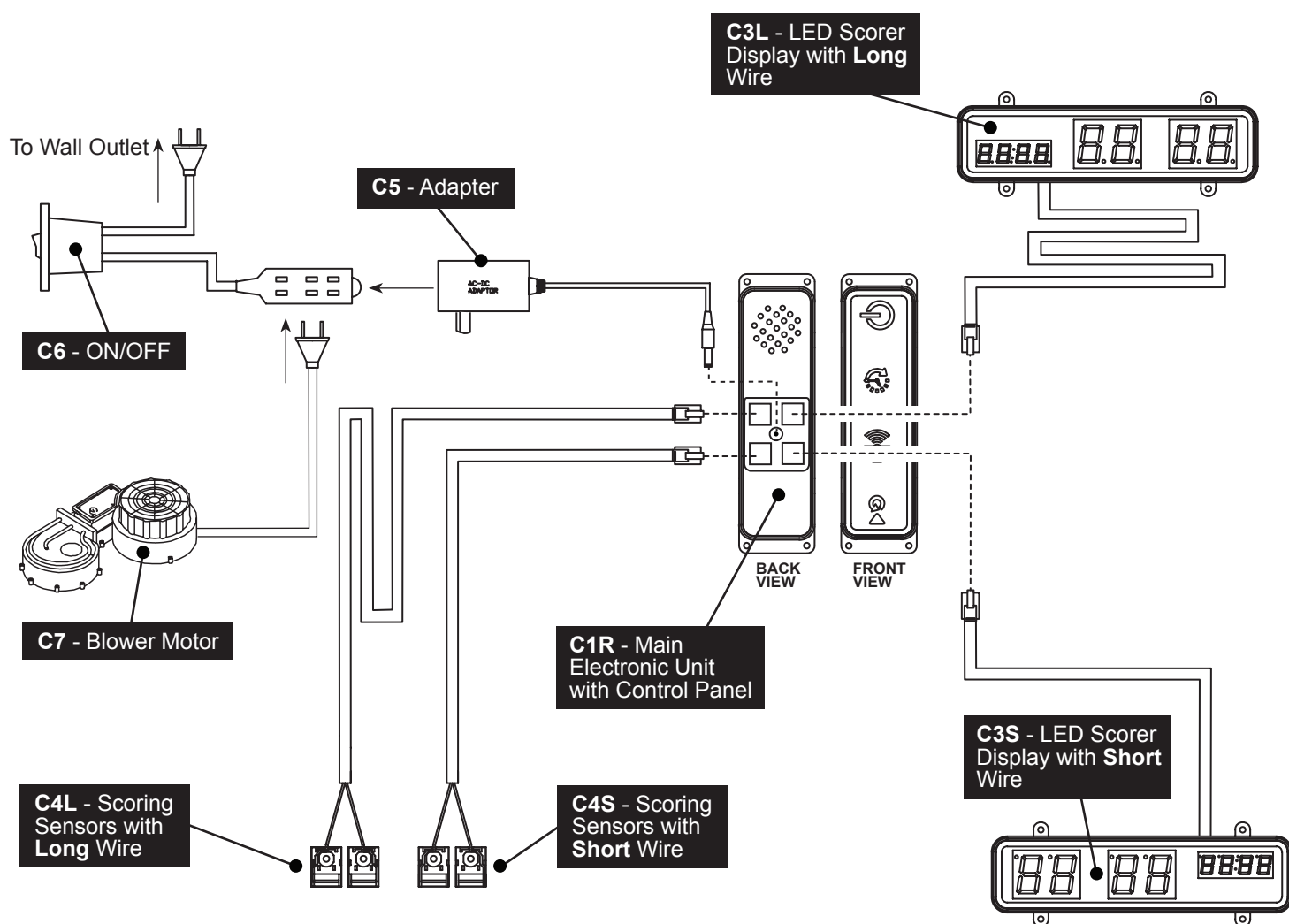
**NOTE:** If no score has been made or the button is not pressed for 15 minutes, the scoreboard will automatically turn off. However we suggest turning the power off when the game will not be used for an extended period of time.



## HOCKEY GAME RULES:

1. This game is designed to be played with two (2) players, one at each end, or with four (4) players, two at each end of the game table. See Page 10 about ordering information of additional strikers and pucks.
2. Flip a coin to determine who will begin play, or a face-off can be held at the center of the table.
3. Play begins when the puck is placed on the playing surface. Players must hit the puck with the strikers and attempt to shoot into the opponent's goal.
4. One point is awarded when a puck is shot into the opponent's goal.
5. Winning the game: the winning score is accomplished by being the first player to reach a predetermined score or by being the player to score the most points within a given period of time.
